

Viewer Tips and Shortcuts

Map Navigation Using the Mouse

- Click and drag the mouse to pan the map display.
- Press Shift and click the map to re-center on the clicked location.
- Double-click the map to re-center and zoom in at the clicked location.
- To zoom out, press Alt while double-clicking.
- Scroll forward on the mouse wheel to zoom in at the current location.
- Scroll backward on the mouse wheel to zoom out from the current location.
- Press Shift and then click and drag the mouse to draw a rectangle around an area and zoom in. To zoom out, press Alt and Shift when drawing the rectangle.

Map Navigation Using the Keyboard

- Pan the map using the arrow keys.
- Press the “+” key to zoom in to the center of the map.
- Press the “-” key to zoom out from the center of the map.

“Save” and Share a Mapping Session

- Users can save and share a mapping session by using the **Link** tool.



This feature allows the user to save the current map extent. The following information is retained within an HTML link that can be shared with others:

- Map extent
- Visible layers
